Reservations Frequently Asked Questions April 2021

When are you reopening?

Subject to government restrictions

Monday 12th April – Sunday 16th May from 12 noon daily: **Roof Terrace** open for drinks and dining, groups of up to 6 people or up to 12 people from 2 households

Monday 17th May – Sunday 20th June: Roof terrace groups of up to 30 people (seated). **Cocktail bar, Lounge and Restaurant open** for groups of 6 or 2 households of any size

Sunday 21st June special event – **dancefloor** reopens at midnight

The club dancefloor is open Fridays and Saturdays 22:00-03:00

Bad Weather?

The roof has a large, covered area that is weather proof and has heated seats. We stay open in all but the very worst conditions.

Advance bookings via the website are on tables in the covered area

Do you serve food?

Yes, the kitchen is open Wednesday to Sunday serving main meals, small plates and sharing boards. We can also host large parties and private dining events.

How do I make a booking?

For advance bookings please use the reservations function via our website

Groups of **up to 6 people** can be booked automatically. Popular times – especially on Saturdays – maybe fully booked so please select another time or date.

Can I add people to my booking?

The roof has fixed tables and seating, generally arranged in pairs. We can usually increase a table from 5 to 6 but other changes require a new booking.

Duplicated or Consecutive Booking Slots

Please don't make website bookings for - multiple areas at the same time/ multiple time slots. We will allow you to stay longer if there is space available. Each booking slot has a minimum spend requirement of £20pp

How do I book the VIP Pod / Igloo?

The Pod is available year round and holds up to 20. In Summer the doors and roof open wide. In Winter it is enclosed and has heating. A hire fee is payable for exclusive bookings.

What if I am late for my booking?

If your entire group are not present at your reserved time, we may reassign your table. If we are able to seat you, we still require the table to be returned at the finish time. We highly recommend that you arrive a few minutes early.

Cancellations

Cancellations less than 48hrs before your reservation will incur a fee either £5 or £20 per person depending on your booking

When is Closing Time?

Regular closing times are midnight Sunday-Thursday, 3am Friday and Saturday

Over 21s policy?

On Friday and Saturday evenings we operate an over-21s admission policy after 9pm. 18-20 year olds are able to stay and enjoy the venue as part of a pre-booked group.

Under 18s?

Under 18s can be admitted only with an adult family member and must not be on the premises after 22:00

Pets? Sorry, we don't allow pets, although assistance dogs are permitted.

Access? TVC is within a period building, unfortunately there is no lift. There are 78 steps to the roof (4th floor). Toilets are situated on the 2nd floor.

Corkage? If you have a private event and wish to enjoy particular wines that we don't supply – corkage of £15 per bottle applies.

Can I bring my own Cake? – We do offer cakes and desserts at Varsity. If you wish to bring a particular cake for a special event we may charge 'cakeage' of £3 per person. We can provide refrigeration, plates and cutlery.
